The inventory of all the goods cattells chattells creditts & momneyes late belonging to John Hartley of Salterforth in the p'ish of Barnoldswick in the County of Yorke yeoman deceased. Apprized by us whose names are hereunto subscribed the fourth day of January Anno Domi: 1713  
Imprs his apparrell with money in his purse, £2; three coves & one Hefer, £14; one calfe, £1; in hay, £3; one seck of corne, 9s; two carts one paire of wheels one cowp & rathes & one harrow with cart sadle & hackney sadle, £1 11s 6d; four spinning wheels & one old syth, 5s; one axe one spade & hedeing mittons, 2s; in the chamber over parlor: one bed & bedinge, 16s; two arkes, 13s 4d; in the chamber over the house: one paire of bedstockes & one litle ark, 4s; one paire of loomes & furniture, 15s; in malt, £1; one pair of cart ropes, 1s 3d; seven corne staks, 7s; in the parlor: one arke with meale in it, £3 8s; one old cupbord & one deske 3s 6d; one disbord & wooden vessel on it, 10s; two spads, 6d; in the milk house: in butter earthen potts shelves mortar & milk basens, 7s in the house: one cupboard & one long table, 17s; one long setle & one glass cas, 18s; in brass & pewder, £1 17s in wooden vessell, 5s 8d; one chimney briggs tongues & reckon & jack & longalds, 6s 6d; two litle tables five chaires stooles & quishens, 6d; one bread fleake one saltpye one hourglass & shelves & one other table with all other huslemt, 6s 8d.
